INFORMATION: On October 13, 2015, at approximately 8:45 PM, Pittsfield Township Police Officers responded to the 4100 block of Green Meadows Blvd. on a report a female, 22-years-old, who was seven months pregnant and unresponsive. The call was made by the woman's boyfriend, Nathaniel Myers, 24-years-old. Myers advised police that she may have overdosed on heroin. The female was alive when police and other emergency response units arrived on scene. Hospital staff made all attempts to save the lives of the mother and fetus but both died a short time later.

The Pittsfield Township Police Department Detective Bureau conducted an investigation into this incident. It was determined that the mother and the fetus died as a result of a heroin/fentanyl overdose. The heroin was provided to her by Nathaniel Myers. Myers was charged with Delivery Causing Death and a warrant was issued for his arrest. On December 15, 2015, Pittsfield Township Police Officers arrested Nathaniel Myers and he was later arraigned. Bond was set at \$7500.00 cash/surety. Myers remains in police custody at this time.
