Washtenaw County Emergency Management: Emergency Warning Sirens testing March 5th – September 3rd, 2016

Washtenaw County's 81 warning sirens will be tested at Noon on Saturday, March 5th. If there is threat of severe weather on the day of a test, it will be cancelled.

Except for scheduled testing, the sirens will be activated for the following emergencies:

- The National Weather Service has issued a tornado warning
- A Severe thunderstorm has been detected with damaging winds in excess of 70 MPH
- A hazardous materials accident requires immediate protective action by the public
- An, attack on the United States is imminent, underway or has recently occurred

Warning siren activation is a signal to members of the public to immediately go indoors and monitor local Emergency Alert System media outlets for official information.

**Fire Incident: Dumpster Fire
Complaint #16-372**

On February 22, 2016, Pittsfield Township fire personnel responded to Glencoe Hills Dr. and Washtenaw Ave. to put out a dumpster fire.

**Fire Incident: Fatal Crash
Complaint #16-409**

On February 24, 2016, at 7:27 p.m., Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to EB I-94 and US-12, to a crash where a semi-truck hauling cars struck a passenger car causing both vehicles to leave the expressway forcing the car into a tree line.

The passenger in the car did not survive the crash and the driver was critically injured. EB I-94 was closed at US 23 and remained closed while the Michigan State Police investigated the incident.

Pittsfield Township's Fire Department and the Michigan State Police completed the investigation and evacuated the scene at 8:25 p.m. Ypsilanti Township's Fire department provided mutual aid.

On February 26, at 11:41 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2100 block of Arbor Circle West for a reported Breaking and Entering / Home Invasion. The victims reported that someone had broken into their apartment and stole three PS4 units, controllers and games. Three suspects were identified as being involved.

Police Incident: Breaking and Entering / Home Invasion / Assault and Battery
Complaint #16-2365

On February 27, 2016, at 3:24 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2100 block of Arbor Circle West for a reported Breaking and Entering / Home Invasion / Assault and Battery. When the Police arrived the victim was being assaulted by a suspect that had broken into the home. The assault was stopped and the suspect taken into custody.

Police Incident: Breaking and Entering Arrest – Numerous Businesses
Complaint #16-2283

Information: The Pittsfield Township Police Department arrested Giovanni Michael Moot for the rash of burglaries of local restaurants that occurred throughout the month of February. The suspect forced entry into the businesses by prying open the entry/exit door or smashing out the glass window or door and stole money from the cash registers. The detective bureau had developed leads, indicating that Moot was a possible suspect. On February 26, 2016, the Ypsilanti Police Department arrested Moot on outstanding warrants and he was later turned over to the Pittsfield Township Police Department. Moot was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail as a suspect in these burglaries.

On February 29, 2016, Moot was arraigned on three (3) counts of breaking and entering: Taco King, 4079 Stone School Road; Leo's Coney Island, 3644 Carpenter Road; Mark's Midtown Coney Island, 3672 S. State Road, and one (1) count attempt breaking and entering at Bangkok Cuisine, 4119 Stone School Road. Giovanni Moot was arraigned on February 29, 2016, and remains in the custody of the Washtenaw County Jail pending court proceedings.
