### Police Incident: Armed Robbery

On Saturday, March 12, 2016, at approximately 6:53 a.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 5400 block of W. Michigan Ave. for reported Armed Robbery at the Circle K gas station. The suspect entered the gas station/convenience store at approximately 6:52 a.m., and demanded the clerk give him money. A weapon was not seen but was implied. The clerk complied with the suspect's demands and the suspect then left the store. The clerk was not injured during this incident. The suspect fled the scene in a black Ford vehicle, possibly a newer Ford Fusion or Fiesta. **Suspect (S):** White male wearing a black jacket with a hoodie pulled over his head, 5'10" - 6'0" tall with a medium build.
