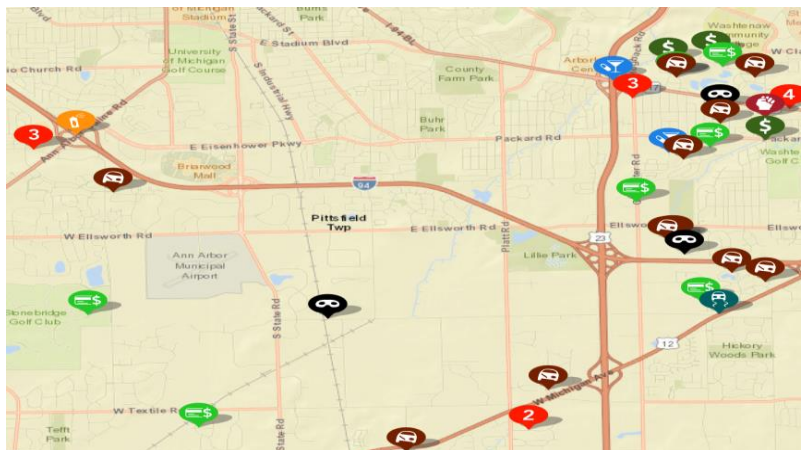

### Crime Prevention Tips: Decreasing Larceny from Motor Vehicles



Pittsfield Twp. Police has responded to an increase in the theft of items from vehicles over the past thirty days. Theft of **cash, cellular phones, computers, purses**, and other items of value have been taken from **unlocked** and **some cases locked** vehicles. Individuals involved with these crimes of opportunity are preying on those who leave valuables out in the open and or may forget that their vehicle is not locked.

**Crime Prevention Tips:** Residents are encouraged to make sure that items in your vehicle are secured in the trunk or in the rear of the **locked vehicle** that cannot be seen by looking in. Remember to close garage doors and to lock the internal doors from the garage to your home.

If you have a video door bell system please set to monitor your driveway in addition to the front /side / rear access points to your home if you have multiple units. If you receive an alert from your system and suspicious person(s) are observed near your vehicle (s) please call 9-1-1.
