Cardboard & Paper Bags Flotten & cut into pieces



Junk Mail
Envelopes, flyers, brochures,
postcards etc.



Newspaper
Remove bags, strings and
rubber bands



Paperboard (Including tetra paks)



Office Paper & Phone Books All types/sizes

METAL

PLASTIC & GLASS



Steel, Tin & Aluminum Cans (Empty Cans only)



Kitchen Cookware Metal pots, pans, tins & utensils



Household Plastics Empty jugs, bottles, etc. #1, #2, #3 & #7 accepted



Clear & Green Glass Empty jugs, bottles, etc.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Batteries
- Chemicals (dry/liquid)
- Compost/food waste
- Concrete
- Electrical cords
- Flammable liquids
- Garbage
- Household cleaners

- Paint cans
- Propane tanks
- Rubber (garden hose/tires/etc.)
- Styrofoam
- Wood items
- Yard waste
- Medical waste (syringes/needles)

OTHER PROGRAMS

Yard Waste Program: Place yard, food, & compost waste into a brown paper yard waste bag or a separate container labeled 'Yard Waste'. Stickers available at Twp. Hall.

Clean Up Voucher Program: Provides every Pittsfield Twp. household with a voucher to the Drop Off Station to recycle/dispose of bulk and unwanted items that cannot be disposed of curbside. Pick your voucher up at Twp. Hall.
