**DTE Scam Alert: What you need to know**

**Fake DTE workers trying to collect money from businesses, homeowners**

**What to do when someone is at your door claiming to be a DTE worker:**

Ask for identification all DTE Electric (formerly Detroit Edison) or DTE Gas (formerly MichCon) employees and contractors carry photo identification badges, and are required to display their badge if asked. You are encouraged to ask for identification.

**On the Phone:**

Ask for identification pull out your most recent DTE Energy bill and ask the caller to tell you the account number and the amount due. If you have caller I.D., the display will indicate that the call is from DTE Energy.

If you suspect the call may be fraudulent, hang up and call DTE toll-free at **800.477.4747**. Ask to be connected to a customer service representative who can confirm the status of your account and make appropriate arrangements for payment, if needed. If you have received a call of this nature and believe you are a victim of fraud, contact your local police immediately.
