PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP (April 23, 2012) — “As part of our commitment to environmental stewardship and public service, this year’s Spring Clean-Up Day will continue to provide Pittsfield Township residents with a free and easy way to recycle and dispose of almost anything,” stated Supervisor Mandy Grewal.

“During our last event, held in October 2011, we unloaded 501 vehicles, recycled 92 tires, 40,400 pounds of electronics (nearly twice the amount collected during the spring 2011 event), and 7.11 tons of scrap metal. We also safely disposed of 16.34 tons of trash,” Grewal reported.

Pittsfield Charter Township will hold its 2012 Spring Clean-Up Day on Saturday, May 12, 2012, between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. at the Robert A. Lillie Township Administration Building, located at 6201 W. Michigan Avenue. Held rain or shine, Clean-up Day is for Pittsfield Township residents only, who will be required to provide proof of residency to participate in this FREE community activity.

Items that will **not** be accepted include paint and paint thinner, aerosols, pesticides, flammables, fertilizer, poisonous, toxic or corrosive materials, regular household garbage, semi-truck and/or Tractor tires larger than 24”, and yard waste.

“I encourage people to plan ahead and mark their calendars for Saturday, May 12, 2012, to take advantage of this free opportunity to recycle and dispose of unwanted items in an environmentally friendly manner,” concluded Grewal.
