Michigan Ave. Firefighters arrived on-scene to find heavy fire showing from the rear of the home. Firefighters conducted an aggressive interior attack and quickly extinguished the fire. Firefighters performed a search of the structure and located 3 animals. Firefighters removed a dog and two cats from the burning structure. Firefighters along with HVA paramedics attempted to resuscitate the animals but were unsuccessful. The residents were not home at the time of the fire and no one was injured during the incident. The fire was caused by an unattended candle and was unintentional.
