INFORMATION: Pittsfield Police officers were dispatched to St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, where a twenty-five year old Pittsfield resident presented with a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the arm. Initial reports indicated a shooting occurred in the 2100 block of Glencoe Hills Drive.

Throughout the night, Pittsfield Police officers, assisted by deputies with Washtenaw County Sheriff's Office and officers with Redford Police, were able to determine, via interviews and scene investigation that the incident occurred in Detroit. Additionally, officers successfully located a firearm hidden in the apartment complex and a vehicle damaged by gunfire that were involved. The matter was turned over to the Detroit Police Department.
