TYPE OF INCIDENT: Shooting Incident

DATE OF INCIDENT: Friday, August 12, 2022

TIME: 9:53 AM

LOCATION: 7000 block of E. Michigan Ave, Pittsfield Twp.

POLICE COMPLAINT NUMBER: 22-10296

INFORMATION: On the above date and time, Pittsfield Township Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a shooting that just occurred. Officers arrived on scene and identified one victim that had been shot in the leg. The injury was non-life-threatening and officers on scene provided medical aid. The victim was treated and transported to an area hospital for treatment. The case remains under investigation and the suspect fled the scene prior to police arrival. At this time, there is information to indicate the incident was not random and the victim and suspect knew each other. There is no information to indicate there is specific danger to the public.

On 9/22/22, PTPD took an identified suspect into custody without incident and he was transported to the Washtenaw County Jail. The suspect was arraigned on 9/22/22 and is being held on \$75,000/10% cash bond. Charges include Weapons Offenses and Assault With Intent to do Great Bodily Harm Less Than Murder.

VICTIM: 22-year-old Ypsilanti Township resident

INJURIES: Gunshot wound to the right leg.

SUSPECT/APPREHENDED: Daniel Lovell Keener, a 26-year-old Whittaker resident.
