INFORMATION: Pittsfield Township Police officers were dispatched to the above location for a suicidal subject. The caller reported that her son advised he was going to harm himself and had a gun. The suicidal subject was known by family to own/possess two firearms. Members of the Ann Arbor Police Department and the Washtenaw County Metro Crisis Negotiation Team assisted Pittsfield Township officers. The Crisis Negotiation Team made numerous attempts to communicate with the subject. Neighboring apartments were in progress of being evacuated and the Crisis Negotiation Team began contact via loud speaker. The suicidal subject exited the apartment building and was taken into protective custody without further incident. The subject was taken to the University of Michigan Hospital for psychiatric assistance. The subject willingly turned over all firearms to Pittsfield Township Police for safekeeping.
